Arthur from 'Bike It' came in on Wednesday and told the children all about The Big Pedal competition. The Big Pedal is the UK's largest inter-school cycling and scooting challenge that inspires pupils, staff and parents to choose two wheels for their journey to school. On each day of the challenge schools compete to see who can record the greatest number of pupils, staff and parents cycling or scooting to school. We will be recording who cycles over the next two weeks. A school's best five days will determine their final position, but they can log journeys on all ten days if they wish. All schools will be entered into daily prize draws for rewards including bike and scooter stunt shows, equipment and storage if over 15% of your school cycle or scoot on each day of the challenge.
