There will be a second hand uniform sale during the week commencing 16<sup>th</sup> May.

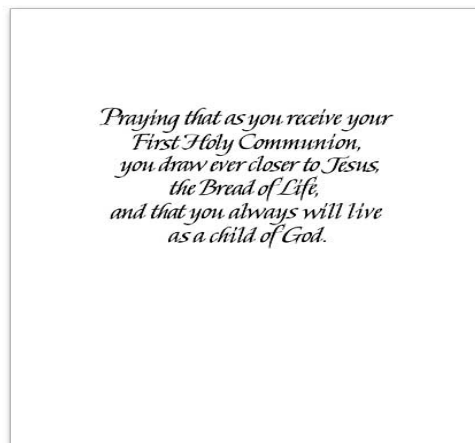
