## New Music Curriculum Recorders Required in KS2!!

As part of the new curriculum we are launching **Charanga Music** on behalf of Barnet Education Arts Trust. We will be teaching music using the Charanga resource materials from Reception to Year 6. Sr Jenny will be teaching it to the Juniors and would like every child in Year 3 to Year 6 to purchase their own recorder to bring to their music lessons every week.

This will enable every child to participate fully in the music lessons and develop their music notation and composition skills. Please ensure the recorders are clearly labelled so the spreading of germs is kept to a minimum.
