- Last year's Year 6 pupils moved onto new horizons in their chosen secondary schools. I know they were well prepared by our staff, their parents, class mates, and parish communities, for the brave and exciting journey ahead. They will be proud ambassadors for our school.
- We started our new school year with the addition of new pupils in our Reception class and a number of pupils joining existing classes. They are all eager to be part of our inclusive community so as to learn, contribute and enable us all to "grow together in the love of God". I know that staff and parents will join me and the Governors in welcoming our new pupils and their families to our school.
- You will have seen that the Friends of St Theresa's have been incredibly industrious, and raised a fantastic amount of money to buy 32 new laptops for our pupils to enhance their learning opportunities. On behalf of the Governors I wish to extend a heartfelt thanks to everyone involved.
- We have a senior leadership team headed by Mrs O'Melia, and supported by Mr Troy, Miss Johnson and Mrs Holland with a wonderful team of dedicated teachers, teaching assistants, mealtime supervisors, office staff, site manager, cleaners and kitchen staff. All are enthusiastic to steer our pupils and the school from strength to strength.

This term I have been meeting regularly with Mrs O'Melia and the Senior Leadership Team (SLT). Our Board's Committees have also been meeting, and together we are updating and refreshing our school's self-evaluation form (SEF), and school improvement plan (SIP). These will be presented to the Governing Board at our next meeting, and will be summarised on the school's website.

This term the SLT have analysed our pupil progress for the last academic year, appointed and inducted new members of staff, monitored curriculum provision and quality of teaching and learning across the school and ensured that the needs of all learners are met. The data analysis from RAISE online for 2016-17 shows that our pupils continue to make very good progress in both Key Stage 1 and 2.

A couple of important messages
