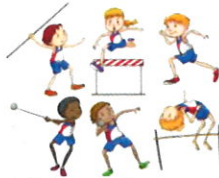
SUMMER TERM TERM 2019 – Friday 21st June 2019

After lunch the children had time to explore all the wildlife and were extremely lucky to see a tiger being fed!

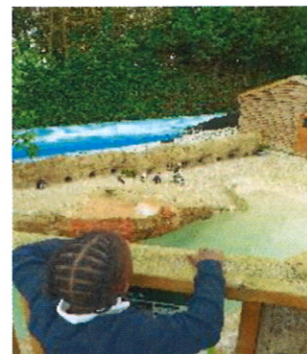
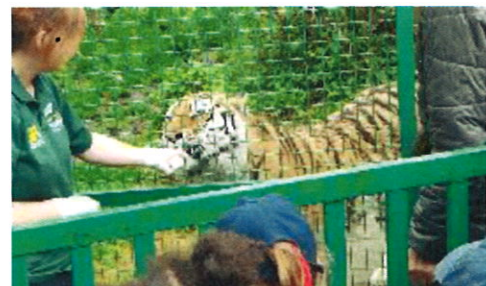
Thank you to all the staff and parent helpers who made this wonderful trip happen.
