Children coming back to school in September

Plans for the opening of the school in September for all our pupils are currently being finalised. The COVID-19 summer food fund

Free school meals in the form of supermarket vouchers will be provided over the summer holidays for all children who are registered for free schools meals. The children at St. Theresa's who are already registered, will continue to receive the supermarket vouchers over the summer holidays. Some families may have children who are entitled to free schools meals but have not registered. Parents of children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 may not realise that their child is eligible for free school meals because of the universal infant free school meal offer.
