Dear Parents and Carers,

Thank you to all the parents in Year 1, Year 2 and Year 6 who attended the parent zoom meetings. We hope you found them useful. A copy of the presentations used in the meetings have been uploaded onto the relevant class page on the school website.

Mr Troy has also added the end of year expectations for each year group (Y1-Y6) in Reading, Writing and Maths to the school website. If you visit your child's class page on the school website you will find a description of what the expected standard (in Reading, Writing and Maths) looks like. In addition to this you will also find the description for the "greater depth" (above average) standard. These descriptors can be very useful in helping parents understand the level their child is expected to achieve by the end of the academic year. We have also included the expected standard for the children in Reception.

Thank you to everyone who has returned the "Student Details" form; we are updating all the emergency contacts we hold for the children. If you have not yet returned the form, please do so as soon as possible.

A reminder to parents that we have changed the home-time pick-up procedure for Y2-Y6. These children are being dismissed directly from their classrooms in order to prevent large crowds of people gathering in the playground. The parents of Y5 and Y6 pupils will need to access the Y5 and Y6 classroom by walking down the path between the Reception outdoor space and the multi-purpose room; the Y5 and Y6 teachers will stand at the classroom doors and dismiss the children to you. All other parents, to avoid congestion, must walk all around the multi-purpose room. Children who walk home alone will be dismissed by the class teachers as normal.

After half term we will be holding parent consultations so that we can update you on your child's progress and attainment. At present, we are not able to hold face-to-face meetings therefore the teachers will be phoning parents. Each class has been assigned two evenings from 4pm – 6.30pm (see the table adjacent for the dates); the teachers will let parents know on Seesaw which evening you have been allocated. On the date you have been allocated, between 4pm-6.30pm you will receive a 10 minute phone-call from the class teacher. The teacher will phone the 1st emergency mobile contact number that we hold for your child. If the day you have been allocated is not convenient, or the 1st emergency mobile contact is not the appropriate number, please contact the class teacher to rearrange.

Families going on holiday during the October half-term
