


In Literacy we will be:

- Looking at the features of instructional writing.
- Writing instructions about how to take care of plants.
- Create our own versions of Jack and The Beanstalk.
- Continue to develop our similes and metaphors to create descriptive writing on settings and characters.
- Develop planning skills for our writing.
- Recap on writing full sentences with correct use of basic punctuation.
- Reading a selection of books about pirates such as 'Jim and the Beanstalk' and 'Ten Seeds.'
- Continuously developing our cursive handwriting.
- Looking at adjectives and expanded noun phrases.
- Using VIPERS in our guided reading sessions to develop skills relating to Vocabulary, Inference, Prediction, Explain, Retrieval, Sequencing.

In Computing we will be:

- Creating masterpieces using different computing programmes.
- Use Microsoft Paint and various apps to create wanted posters and pictures.
- Create art in the style of renowned artists.
- Use cameras to take image of real life things.

In PSHE we will be learning about:

- How we are all valuable and how making mistakes is valuable.

In P.E we will be learning about:

- The importance of keeping fit and healthy.

In our R.E topic 'Mysteries' we will be looking and learning about:

- Why Christians celebrate Christmas.

In our Mathematics learning the class will be looking at:

- Continuing to develop our knowledge of addition and subtraction.
- Looking at bar models to represent different addition and subtraction problems.
- Finding 10 more or 10 less than any given number.
- Measure different lengths of plants and other objects.
- Recognise shapes and different lines of symmetry.
- Continue to learn our 2,3,5 and 10 times tables.
- Count forwards and backwards in 10s from any number.
- Starting to look at multiplication and division problems.

In History and Geography we will be learning about:

- The rainforest and deforestation.
- Where in the world we can find different types of plants.
- Why certain plants can only be found in certain parts of the world.
- Use maps, atlases and globes to identify different countries, continents and oceans.
- Use simple compass directions (North, South, East, West) and locational directional language.

In our Art and Design we will be:

- Research famous artists such as Van Gogh and Piet Mondrian.
- Evaluate our designs and models.
- Study work of famous past artists.

In Science we will be learning about plants, looking at;

- Identify, group and compare different types of plants.
- Looking at different types of seed dispersal.
- To find out and describe how plants need water light and a suitable temperature to grow.
- Making predictions and evaluations.
- The lifecycle of a plant.
- Design and carry out experiments, ensuring they are a fair test.
