In English we will be:

- Reading a selection of books about the Weather
- Learning the initial sounds
- Looking at the spelling pattern for th, sh, ch, qu, ai, ay, oi, oy, a-e, e-e, i-e, o-e, u-e
- Continuously developing our cursive handwriting.
- Reading poems about the weather
- Looking at adjectives when describing the weather
- Writing postcards
- Recap on writing full sentences with correct use of basic punctuation.

In Science we will be learning about Light and Dark

- Investigate different light sources
- Understand that light cannot pass through some materials.
- Explore how light is reflected
- Know what light symbolises in different cultures and festivals
- Investigate nocturnal animals.

In our R.E topic 'Mary, Our Mother' we will be looking and learning about:

- The Annunciation
- Mary visits Elizabeth
- Advent
- The birth of Jesus
- Visit of the Shepherds
- Mary is our Mother

In Computing we will be: Creating images

- Learn to paint with different colours
- Use undo or eraser to correct mistakes
- Explore different tools such as brush, pen, line, shape and fill

Year 1 Autumn Half Term Topic:

Splendid Skies







In P.E we will be learning about: Dance

- Explore travelling actions, movement skills and balancing.
- Understand why it is important to count to music and use this in their dances.
- Copy and repeat actions linking them together to make short dance phrases.
- Work individually and with a partner to create ideas in relation to the theme.
- Perform and also to provide feedback, beginning to use dance terminology to do so.

In our Art and Design, we will be:

- Use drawing and painting to develop and share their ideas
- Use a range of materials creatively to design and make products.
- Learn about the work of a range of artists

In our Mathematics learning the class will be looking at:

- Recognise and name common 2D and 3D shapes, including rectangles, squares, circles and triangles, cuboids, pyramids and spheres.
- Describe position, direction and movement, including whole, half, quarter and three quarter turns
- Count to twenty, forwards and backwards, beginning with 0 or 1, from any given number.
- Count, read and write numbers from 1 to 20 in numerals and words.
- Identify and represent numbers using objects and pictorial representations including the number line, and use the language of: equal to, more than, less than (fewer), most, least.
- Count in multiples of twos and fives
- Use number bonds and related subtraction facts within 20.
- Add and subtract one digit and two digit numbers to 20, including zero.
- Solve one step problems that involve addition and subtraction, using concrete objects and pictorial representations, and missing number problems such as 7=?-9

In Geography we will be learning about:

- Seasonal and daily weather patterns in the UK
- Locate hot and cold countries of the world in relation to the Equator and the North and South Poles.
- Use basic geographical vocabulary to refer to key physical features including season and weather.
- Recognise basic human and physical features
