Earlier this evening, the government announced that in order to help contain the community transmission of coronavirus (COVID-19), some restrictions to primary schools are required in certain areas. These restrictions will be in place from 4th January and the operational guidance published by the government sets out the actions that these schools should take. The guidance can be read here:
