Dear Parents and Carers,

On Wednesday the Year 6 children were excited to have their World War II workshop as part of their topic learning. The children came dressed in clothes that school children in the 1940s would have worn and then spent the day in the hall experiencing what school was like in a 1940's classroom! A huge thank you to the Friends who heavily subsidised the cost of this workshop.

Next week, we will begin our parent phone consultations so that you have an opportunity to speak to your child's class teacher. Each class teacher has been assigned one day (see the table adjacent for the dates) to make the phone-calls. At some point during the day, on the date your child's class has been allocated, you will receive a 10 minute phone-call from the class teacher. The teacher will phone the 1st emergency mobile contact number that we hold for your child. If the day you have been allocated is not convenient, or the 1st emergency mobile contact is not the appropriate number, please contact the class teacher to rearrange.

The school has been provided further funding to distribute as part of the COVID-19 Winter Fund Scheme; this funding is available to support families/households affected by COVID-19. The funding is being used to provide supermarket vouchers for the Easter Holiday period for identified families, including those whose children are entitled to free school meals. If you received this funding over the Christmas holidays and the half term, you will be receiving it again now; you will shortly be receiving an email from WONDE for the amount of £23 per child. Once you have received the email, please follow its instructions.

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Asymptomatic Testing for Parents and adults in households with Children at School

Parents and other adults in households with children at school or college, who do not have symptoms, can now access regular, rapid coronavirus (COVID-19) testing. This includes childcare and support bubbles. Here are the different ways for a household, childcare or support bubble to collect their test:

- Through your employer if they offer testing to employees.
 Contact your employer to find out more.
- At a local test site.
 - To find your nearest test site visit <u>https://maps.test-and-trace.nhs.uk/</u>.
- By collecting a home test kit from a test site.
 - You can collect 2 packs of home test kits at a local collection point. Each pack contains 7 tests.
 - $\circ~$ Anyone 18 or over can collect.
 - Most collection points are open from 1.30pm to 7pm. You can check online if the location is open or busy before you go. You do not need to make an appointment.
 - Do not visit a collection point outside opening hours, as it may be used to test people with coronavirus symptoms outside these times.
 - To find your nearest home test kit collection point visit <u>https://find-covid-19-rapid-test-sites.maps.test-and-trace.nhs.uk/findatestcenter.html</u>
 - By ordering a home test kit online.
 - If you cannot get tested at your workplace, or are unable to go to a test site or collect test kits, you can order a home test kit online.
 - Do not order online if you can get a test through other methods. This frees up home delivery for those who need it most.
