

In Literacy we will be:

- Reading a selection of books about the Solar System
- Continuing to learn the initial sounds, Phase 2, Phase 3, Phase 4 and 5.
- Continuously developing our cursive handwriting.
- Reading poems about Space
- Recap on writing full sentences with correct use of basic punctuation.
- Description of a Space Buggy/Alien
- Write a story about Space based on the story of Whatever Next
- Newspaper report based on the First Landing on the Moon

In Science we will be learning about Materials looking at:

- Learn about the properties of everyday materials.
- Investigate how to make a model Moon Buggy travel a short distance.
- Perform a simple test related to the formations of moon craters.

In our R.E topic 'Discipleship' we will be looking and learning about:

- Recall information about the Gospel of Mark
- Say what it means to be a disciple.
- Retell some special stories about religious events and people
- Understand the context of the calling story in Mark's Gospel.
- Explain what it means to be a follower of Jesus.

In Computing we will be:

- Using ipads – Reading Eggs
- Recognise common uses of information technology beyond school.
- Use technology purposefully to create, organise, store, manipulate and retrieve digital content.
- Understand what algorithms are; how they are implemented as programs of digital devices; and that programs execute by following precise and unambiguous instructions.
- Create and debug simple programs.

In our Art and Design, we will be:

- Use drawing, painting and to develop and share ideas, experiences and imagination
- Learn about the work of a range of artists, craft makers and designers, describing the differences and similarities between different practises and disciplines, making links to their own work
- Drawing and painting Solar System planets

In P.E we will be learning about: Sending and Receiving

- Develop sending and receiving skills including throwing and catching, rolling, kicking, tracking and stopping a ball
- Use equipment to send and receive a ball.
- Apply skills individually, in pairs and in small groups and begin to organise and self-manage

In our Mathematics learning the class will be looking at:

- Count forwards and backwards within 100
- Partition numbers
- Counting to 100 and backwards
- Ordering numbers and comparing numbers to 100 < >
- Recognising coins and notes
- One more, one less
- Read time- o'clock, half past
- Understand dates

In Geography we will be learning about:

- To use basic geographical vocabulary to refer to physical features, including: beach, cliff, coast, forest, hill, mountain, sea, ocean, river, soil, valley, vegetation, season and weather.

In History we will be learning about:

- To learn about events beyond living memory (Moon landing).
- To learn about the lives of significant individuals in the past who have contributed to national and international achievement (Neil Armstrong)
