In English we will be:

- Looking at the features of job applications
- Produce a job application for the chosen king
- Articulate and justify answers, arguments and opinions
- Understand the features of a kenning poem
- Plan and produce own poem
- Look at features of a play script
- To plan and perform script in groups
- Retrieve and record information from fiction and non- fiction texts
- Develop planning skills for our writing.
- Looking at a range of interesting sentence openers in our writing.
- Continuously developing our cursive handwriting.

In Science we will be learning about Sounds and Vibrations and looking at;

- Identify how sounds are made associating sound with vibrations.
- Make links between the volume of a sound and the size of a vibration.
- Make links between the pitch of the sound and the object making the sound.
- Understand that the distance travelled affects the sound.

In P.E we will be learning about Hockey:

- To implement the basic rules of Hockey
- Perform basic dribbling and passing techniques
- Increase speed and endurance during play.

In Music we will be learning about:

- We will be focusing on the song 'Mamma Mia' by Abba.
- We will learn to sing the song and in addition to this, learning to play the glockenspiel and the recorder to accompany this song.

In Computing we will be learning about animation:

- To be able to explain what is meant by animation.
- Create a series of linked frames that can be played as a short animation.
- Control and adjust a time slider to locate a different point in a film clip.
- Insert images to create a simple stop motion animation short film clip.
- Evaluate the advantages and disadvantages of some animation software.
