

In Communication & Language we will be:

- learning new vocabulary
- developing social phrases
- listening to and talk about stories to build familiarity and understanding
- engage in non-fiction books
- retell the story once they have developed a deep familiarity with the text

In Understanding of the World we will :

- name and describe people who are familiar to us
- explore the natural world around us ,making observations and drawing pictures of animals and plants.
- draw information from a simple map
- understand some important processes and changes in the natural world around them ,including the seasons and changing states of matter.

In Literacy we will :

- develop our phonological awareness so we can spot and suggest rhymes, recognise words with the same initial and count or clap syllables in a word
- engage in extended conversations about stories , learning new vocabulary
- read a few common exception words matched to the school's phonic programme
- read simple phrases and sentences made up words with letter sound correspondences
- demonstrate understanding of what has been read to them by retelling stories and narratives using their own words and recently introduced vocabulary


In Physical Development we will be:
