Dear Parents and Carers,

A reminder to Y1 parents that the statutory Y1 Phonic Screening is approaching. Each child in Y1 must sit the test after half term - week beginning 6th June. Y2 pupils who did not meet the expected standard in the 2021 autumn check will also retake the test. If you have any queries regarding your child's phonics progress, please do speak to Mrs Reimus or Miss Gulab.

After the May half-term, on Tuesday 7th June, Father John will be coming to celebrate Mass for the school's feast day at 1.30pm; parents are very welcome to attend.

On Thursday 16th June at 3.45pm in the school hall, we will be holding a meeting for all the current Reception parents. This meeting will give you information about your child's transition into Year 1 in September. Please make the effort to attend this meeting as routines, procedures, curriculum content and the learning environment in Y1 are very different to the provision in Reception. Your child's time in the EYFS is coming to an end and it is important for you to understand how different the teaching and learning in Key Stage 1 (Year 1 and Year 2) will be. A crèche will be available during the meeting should you wish to use it; if your child does stay in the hall for the duration of the meeting please ensure they remain seated and quiet.

By the time this newsletter goes out, we will be in the swing of the school's Queen's Platinum Jubilee celebrations! Have a lovely half-term holiday and remember, the school Monday 6th June; the c on Tuesday 7th June.
