

In English we will be:

- Exploring the features of a newspaper report.
- Identifying and using the 5 W's + 1 H (Who, What, When, Where, Why and How)
- Learning how to distinguish between fact and opinion
- Using reported speech.
- Planning and publishing a newspaper report
- Gaining an understanding of the culture of Viking life through the retelling of Viking saga
- Perform and write a Viking saga

In Science we will be learning about Living Things:

- Devise questions that can be used to construct keys.
- Use simple keys to identify organisms.
- State the living requirements of some invertebrates.
- Begin to make simple keys to identify a range of living things.
- Explain simply why living things need to be classified.

In P.E we will be learning about:

- Practice existing running, throwing and jumping skills
- Learn new athletic events and skills such as triple jump.

In Music we will be learning about Gospel songs:

- To know five songs from memory and who sang them or wrote them.
- To know the style of the five songs.
- To choose one song and be able to talk about it
- Identify the main sections of the song (introduction, verse, chorus etc).

In Computing we will be learning about Word processing:

- Select, edit and manipulate text in different ways
- Insert an image into a document
- Format an image
- Use formatting tools to improve the layout
- Use the spellcheck tool
- Insert a simple table
- Change the size of the page
- Change the layout by using the column tool

In PSHE we will be learning about 'I AM THANKFUL' TenTen

- Viking and Anglo-Saxon struggle for the Kingdom of England to the time of Edward the Confessor
- Describing the significance and impact of power struggles on Britain
- Gathering relevant information in a historical report, fictional narrative, in-depth study or by answering a range of historical questions.

In our R.E topic 'From Easter to Pentecost' we will be looking and learning about:

- Retell the events of the Easter Season from the writing of Luke
- Know that the resurrection of Jesus is a fundamental belief of Christians
- Explain how the Resurrection and Post-Resurrection appearances lead to belief in the divinity of Christ.
- Make connections between two sources of revelation by finding belief in the resurrection within the Creed or other expression of faith.
