#### Dear Parents and Carers.

Thank you to everyone who supported the Friends' movie nights; they raised £570. Remember, all the money raised, goes towards buying new iPads for the children.

On Wednesday, Liam Joughin - from the charity organisation 'The Passage' - came to speak to the children in assembly. Their mission is preventing street homelessness by intervening quickly before people reach crisis point. The Passage takes its values and ethos from the teachings and example of St. Vincent De Paul, a Christian and social reformer who cofounded the Daughters of Charity in 1633. Vincent believed in action rather than words and in hands-on service to vulnerable people. We are inviting the children to support The Passage by donating £2 on Wednesday 14th December (Christmas Jumper Day).

## Christmas/Red Jumper Day Wednesday 14th December!



The children are invited to come to school on Wednesday 14th December replacing just the top part of their uniform with a Christmas or red jumper in return for a donation £2. The money raised will be donated to 'The Passage'. The Passage runs London's largest voluntary sector resource centre for homeless and vulnerable people.

#### School Lunches

Y3-Y6 Parents: your child could be entitled to free school meals Your child may be able to get free school meals if you get any of the following:

- Income Support
- income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- the guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)

Please speak to a member of the school office team if you think your child may be eligible for free school meals.

## Dismissing children from After-School Clubs

We ask parents/carers who are collecting their child from an after school club to wait outside the main school office entrance.

#### Parent Volunteers

In line with Government safeguarding advice for all schools, the school will complete police checks, and request references, for volunteers before they start working with the children.
