In Literacy we will be:

- Reading a selection of books about London, including Paddington at the Palace, Katie in London, Mr. Men in London and Charlie and Lola: We Must Completely Go to London.
- Continuing to learn the initial sounds, Phase
 2, Phase 3, Phase 4 and 5.
- Continuously developing our cursive handwriting.
- Reading and looking at poems and rhymes.
- Learning about and writing recounts.
- Describing feelings for diary entry.
- Writing a entry diary about the Great Fire of London.
- Recap on writing full sentences with correct use of basic punctuation.

In Science we will be learning about Plants looking at:

- Identify and name a variety of common wild and garden plants, including deciduous and evergreen trees
- identify and describe the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants, including trees

In our R.E topic 'Easter to Pentecost' we will be looking and learning about:

- The story of the resurrection according to Matthew.
- Jesus's Ascension.
- The story of Pentecost.
- Pope Francis.

In P.H.S.E we will be:

- Learning about what a family is and that there are different types of families.
- Learning to identify what being a good friend means.
- Learning about appropriate ways to greet friends physically.
- Learning about who can help us in our school community.
- Learning to recognise my qualities as a person and friend.
- Learning to express why we appreciate a person/people that are special to us.

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In our Art and Design, we will be:

- Use drawing, painting and to develop and share ideas, experiences and imagination
- Making different things out of junk modelling, e.g. buses, buildings and cars.
- Drawing and painting London landmarks

In P.E we will be learning about: Ball Skills

- Develop throwing and catching, rolling, hitting a target, dribbling with both hands and feet and kicking a ball.
- Work independently, in pairs and small groups.
- Explore their own ideas in response to tasks.

In our Mathematics learning the class will be looking at:

- Counting in 2s, 5s and 10s
- Recognising and making equal groups to solve multiplication and division problems and number sentences.
- Recognising and making arrays to solve multiplication and division number sentences and problems.
- Recognising halves and quarters of shapes, objects and quantities.
- Describing turn and directions.
- Counting to 100 and backwards.

In Geography we will be learning about:

- Name, locate and identify characteristics of the four countries and capital cities of the UK and its surrounding seas.
- Use simple compass directions (North, South, East and West) and locational and directional language (e.g. near and far; left and right), to describe the location of features and routes on a map.
- Use basic geographical vocabulary to refer to key human features, including: city, town, village, factory.

In History we will be learning about:

- Events beyond living memory that are significant nationally or globally.
- The lives of significant individuals in the past.
- Significant historical events, people and places in their own locality (The Great Fire of London.)
- Changes within living memory.
