<u>The Wednesday Word</u> "To have courage for whatever comes in life – everything lies in that." *St Teresa of Avila* Ask your child what the word 'courage' means to them. #### Packed Lunch Guidelines

A reminder to all parents that St. Theresa's School is a nut free school and therefore **packed lunches must not contain any nut products; this includes Nutella**. The school requests that all parents adhere to the school packed lunch guidelines; please see below.

Packed lunches should include		Packed lunches should NOT include
•	At least one portion of fruit and one portion of vegetable or salad every day	<ul> <li>Crisps</li> <li>Confectionery such as chocolate bars, chocolate-coated biscuits</li> </ul>
•	Meat, fish or another source of non-dairy protein, every day. Non- dairy sources of protein include lentils, kidney beans, chickpeas, hummus and falafel	<ul> <li>We are a nut free school – please do not send in any food containin nuts. This includes Nutella and</li> </ul>
•	An oily fish, such as salmon, at least once every three weeks	other chocolate spreads.
•	A starchy food, such as bread or pasta, rice, couscous, noodles, potatoes or other cereals, every day	
•	A dairy food, such as milk, cheese, yoghurt, fromage frais or custard every day	
•	Water, still or sparkling, fruit juice, semi-skimmed or skimmed milk, yoghurt or milk drinks and smoothies	
•	Acceptable snacks includes: seeds, vegetables and fruit (with no added salt, sugar or fat). Savoury crackers or breadsticks served with fruit, vegetables or dairy food are also a good choice	

You may also include:

- Cakes and biscuits are allowed but these should be part of a balanced meal
- Meat products such as sausage rolls, individual pies, corned meat and sausages / chipolatas should be included only occasionally
