Macmillan Coffee Morning Friday 29th September



On Friday 29th September we will be participating in the MacMillan Coffee morning. It is MacMillan's biggest fundraising event for people facing cancer. Macmillan's goal is to make sure no one faces cancer alone.

The coffee morning will run in the Multi-Purpose room and parents will be able to come and have a cup of tea/coffee and a slice of cake! The children will be able to buy a cake and a cup of squash, to enjoy in their classrooms, for a donation of £1. If you are able to support this event by donating cakes/biscuits etc. please drop your contribution off to the school office by the morning of the 29th. We are very grateful for your support.

Message from Public Health

Make sure your child is up to date with their MMR vaccine as they head back to school.

Measles is more than just a rash, with 1 in 5 children needing a hospital visit.

Currently we are seeing an increase in measles cases circulating in neighbouring London boroughs, so now is a good time to check that your child's MMR vaccination - which not only protects your child against measles but also mumps and rubella - is up to date.

Only 72% of under 5s in Barnet are fully vaccinated against it which is well below the World Health Organisations target of 95% needed to prevent an outbreak.

Measles is a highly contagious disease and can lead to complications such as ear infections, pneumonia, and inflammation of the brain which require hospitalisation and on rare occasions can lead to long term disability or death.

Protect your family against possible serious illness and avoid self-isolation.

Vaccination is the best protection. Check your child's red book and contact your GP to make sure they are up to date on their routine vaccinations.

The Wednesday Word

"Pray and forgive." St Teresa of Calcutta

This Sunday's Gospel reminds us that we must try to forgive others in the same way that we want God (and others) to forgive us. Ask your child what the word 'forgiveness' means to them. Has your child ever asked for and received forgiveness? How did it feel to be forgiven? It may help your child if you tell them about a time when you forgave someone, especially when it wasn't easy to do, or when you were forgiven.

"It is by forgiving that one is forgiven." St Teresa of Calcutta (Mother Teresa)

Forgiveness is one of God's greatest gifts to us. Each of you say how it feels to forgive someone and make friends again. As we start this new school year, ask your child if there is anyone whose forgiveness they would like. Is anyone they need to forgive? If so, share ideas about how to do this. Perhaps they can: talk gently and lovingly to that person if there is a problem; try to recognize some good qualities in that person; pray and ask God to help them forgive. The online application system for our Year 6 parents is now open at www.eadmissions.org.uk

All parents must apply online. If you need support please feel free to contact the school for support, or call the School Admissions Customer Services Team on 020 8359 7651.

Parents of children in Y6 who have an Educational Health Care Plan will need to complete a different form this will have been sent to you by the Barnet SEN team.

The deadline for submitting your application is Monday 31st October 2023. Applications received after 31st October will be treated as late. Late applications will not be considered until after the on-time applicants have been allocated their school places. This means that late applicants are unlikely to be offered one of their preferred schools. If there is a good reason as to why your application is late; for example you moved to the area after the closing date, you must contact the admissions department by 12th December 2023 at the latest.
