### Dear Parents and Carers,

On Tuesday we celebrated World Mental Health Day. Research shows that mental health has declined in almost 40% of school children (NHS Survey). The theme this year was "Get Britain Talking" - designed to help ease our stress and reduce our anxiety by asking what's on our minds.

Thank you to all the parents who attended the Phonics Meeting on Tuesday; we hope you found it useful. If you have a child with some challenging emotions and/or behaviour, these workshops will discuss some of the ways this can add pressure on parents, both mentally and emotionally. Katrina will be talking about some tools and information to help parents feel more able to cope, and to help your child make progress. A crêche will be available for the younger children if you wish to use it.

On Thursday the Y6 parents are hosting the Halloween Disco 6-8pm; this is always a very popular event for the children. Please do come and support the fundraising event and I look forward to seeing you there.

# Year 6 Secondary Transfer Information

The online application system for our Year 6 parents is now open at <u>www.eadmissions.org.uk</u>

All parents must apply online. If you need support please feel free to contact the school for support, or call the School Admissions Customer Services Team on 020 8359 7651.

Parents of children in Y6 who have an Educational Health Care Plan will need to complete a different form – this will have been sent to you by the Barnet SEN team.

The deadline for submitting your application is Monday 31<sup>st</sup> October 2023. Applications received after 31<sup>st</sup> October will be treated as late. Late applications will not be considered until after the on-time applicants have been allocated their school places. This means that late applicants are unlikely to be offered one of their preferred schools. If there is a good reason as to why your application is late; for example you moved to the area after the closing date, you must contact the admissions department by 12<sup>th</sup> December 2023 at the latest.
