In Communication & Language we will be:

- Talking about our interests and developing vocabulary around these interests.
- Developing negotiation skills during play and learning how to express our feelings and emotions appropriately.
- Learning to answer 'how' and 'why' questions.

In Maths we will be:

- Learning to identify and name circles and triangles.
- Learning more about the numbers up to
- Learning about some four sided shapes.
- Learning about position.
- Practising counting, recognising and forming numbers.

In Literacy we will be:

- Promoting a love of books and providing opportunities to explore different texts.
- Practising writing our names and forming recognisable letters.
- Introducing phonics sounds which will be applied in reading and writing.

In Physical Development we will be:

- Learning the cursive script for handwriting.
- Learning about safe spaces in PE, and moving around safely.
- Practising throwing and catching.
- Exploring different ways of moving.

In Personal, Social and Emotional Development we will be:

- Developing our social interactions, and building relationships, with adults and children.
- Following daily routines.
- Developing our independence.

In Understanding of the World we will be:

- Learning about day and night.
