

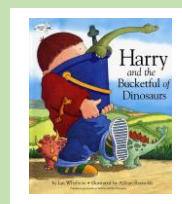
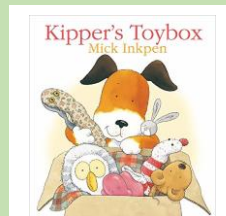
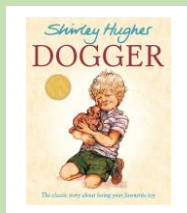
In English we will be:

- Learning about phonemes and graphemes, blending and segmenting during our Phonics lessons.
- Learning how to read and spell the Year 1 Common Exception Words.
- Reading a selection of books about toys such as Kipper's Toy box and Dogger.
- Learning the initial sounds and letter names.
- Continuously developing our cursive handwriting.
- Continuing to learn how to form our capital letters correctly.
- Learning about nouns and verbs.
- Learning to write a full sentence using basic punctuation marks.
- Learning how to use the suffix 'ing.'
- Learning about the present and past tenses.
- Writing invitations.
- Writing descriptions.
- Learning about the features of a diary entry.
- Writing a diary entry.
- Act out own and well known stories using voices for character.

In Computing our topic is, "We are Treasure Hunters," and we will be:

- Learning and discussing how to be safe on the internet.
- Move a programmable toy in different directions
- Give and follow instructions

Year 1 Autumn Half Term Topic: Memory Box



In PSHE our topic this term is, 'Being Me in My World' and we will be:

- Identifying our hopes and fears for the year.
- Understanding our rights and responsibilities as a member of our class and school.
- Listen to and contribute views about rewards and consequences.
- Understand how following the learning charter will help me and others to learn.
- Recognise the choices I make and understand the consequences.

In our Mathematics learning the class will be learning to:

- Sort, count and represent numbers to 10.
- Read and write numbers from 0 to 10.
- Find one more and one less than numbers up to 10.
- Understand and demonstrate an understanding of one to one correspondence for numbers up to 10.
- Compare and order numbers, using the <, > and = signs.
- To use ordinal numbers when comparing.
- To use number lines and other methods to represent numbers up to 10.

In History we will be learning about:

- Changes within living memory
- Finding out about toys today.
- Explaining how we can find out about the past.
- Find out about toys in the past.
- Compare similar toys from different times.
- Compare Victorian toys with modern toys.

In Science we will be learning about animals including humans. We will:

- Identify, name, draw and label the basic parts of the human body.
- Learn about which parts of the body we use to see, hear, taste, smell and feel.
- Observe things using simple equipment.
- Identify and sort different things.
- Collect and record data to help answer different questions.

In P.E we will be learning about: Athletics

- Develop skills required in athletic activities such as running at different speeds, changing direction, jumping and throwing.

In our R.E topic 'In the Beginning,' we will be looking at and learning about:

- Our school prayers and mission statement.
- Creation stories.
- The letter that Pope Francis wrote, the Laudato Si.
- Learning about psalms.

In our Art and Design, we will be:

- Use drawing and painting to develop and share their ideas
- Use a range of materials creatively to design and make products.
