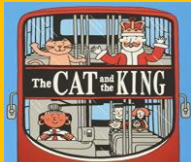


In Literacy we will be:

- reading Nick Sharratt's fabulously funny novel "The Cat and the King" and Robert Munsch & Michael Martchenko's "The Paper Bag Princess"
- looking at new model text and learning the stories by drawing story maps, retelling them and acting them out
innovating the stories and making simple changes to the model next and writing their own versions
writing instructions – How to make a paper crown.
- writing biographies of Monarchs



In Computing we will be looking at: Robot Algorithms, where the learners will develop their understanding of instructions in sequences and the use of logical reasoning to predict outcomes.

Year 2 Spring 2 Topic: Magnificent Monarchs



This project teaches children about the English and British monarchy from AD 871 to the present day. Using timelines, information about royal palaces, portraits and other historical sources, they build up an understanding of the monarchs and then research six of the most significant sovereigns.

In REHC we will be learning about: "Feelings, Likes and Dislikes, looking at:

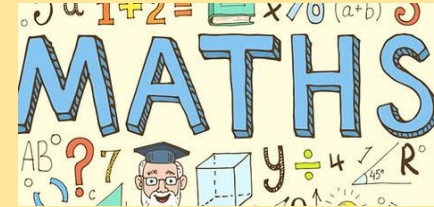
- what is natural for us to relate to and trust one another

In our Mathematics learning the class will be looking at:

- multiplication and Division
- money
- length and Height
- fractions
- position and direction



In History and Geography, we will be looking at:

- historical vocabulary
 - historical periods - Timelines
 - power and rule
 - historical artefacts
- significant people- Alfred the Great, William the conqueror, Henry VIII, Elizabeth I, Queen Victoria, Elizabeth II, Bayeux tapestry, Feudal system, Actions and impact, Historical models
- significant places- royal residence

In Science we will be learning about Plants-Young Gardeners, looking at:

- functions of plant parts
- naming different plants
- growing from seeds and conditions for growth
- planning when is best to grow vegetables
- planting to attract insects
- recycling in the garden

In our R.E topic 'From Lent to Easter' we will be:

- looking and learning about the main events, characters and places in the life of Jesus: Palm Sunday, the Last Supper, Good Friday and Easter Sunday.
- Making simple connections between belonging to church and living out our faiths

In our Art and Design, we will:

- learn about different food and food groups
- taste a variety of breads and examine textures, flavours.
- design a sandwich for the King (Topic focus- what Monarchs ate in the past)
- create a sandwich
- evaluate sandwich
