- To ask simple questions and recognize that they can be answered in different ways

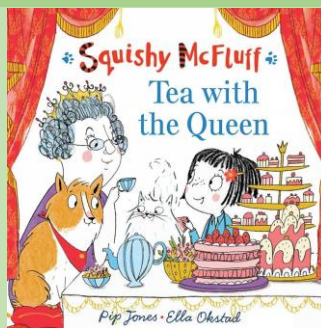
In our R.E topic 'To the ends of the Earth' we will be learning :
