#### <u>The Wednesday Word</u> ""The kingdom is hidden within you; it is found in your own soul." St Isaac of Nineveh

#### **Barnet Family Autism Hub**

Barnet Family Services are excited to share they are in the beginning stages of creating a *Barnet Family Autism Hub* in conjunction with Resources for Autism. This initiative aims to create a neuro-affirmative space for those who love and care for Autistic children and young people, providing a one-stop community hub where families can access pre- and post-diagnosis information and resources. The support offered will be based on family needs rather than solely on diagnosis. The hub will feature multi-agency collaboration from the voluntary sector, education, social care, and health services.

Barnet has requested schools share this information with the parents of Autistic children, those on the pathway to diagnosis, and those identified as having social communication differences

To ensure the hub meets community needs, as many parents as possible are being encouraged to participate in a survey, as your feedback is crucial in shaping the services and support provided.
