

In Literacy we will be:

- Looking at the features of Newspaper reports.
- Developing planning skills for our writing.
- Creating well-structured and informative newspaper reports about an important Tudor event.
- Using a range of sources to learn about Tudor monarchs and life in Tudor England.
- To look at features and structure of persuasive letters
- To include arguments to support persuasive letter
- To look at riddles in Poetry and create our own.
- Using capital letters for proper nouns.
- Learning the difference between direct and reported speech.
- Learning to use inverted commas correctly for direct speech.

In Science our topic will be 'let's get moving' (Forces) looking at:

- Explain that unsupported objects fall towards the Earth because of the force of gravity acting between the Earth and the falling object
- Identify the effects of air resistance, water resistance and friction, that act between moving surfaces
- Recognise that some mechanisms, including levers, pulleys and gears, allow a smaller force to have a greater effect.

In Computing we will be:

- What a video is and filming techniques.
- Using a storyboard and planning a video.
- Importing and editing videos and video evaluation.

In P.E our focus will be football. We will be learning to:

- Apply a variety of turning and shielding skills in opposed scenarios.
- To pass the ball accurately over a short distance. Develop basic receiving skills whilst under pressure from an opponent.

Year 5 Autumn 2 Half Term Topic: The Tudors



In PSHE, our topic will be 'God is Calling'. It will focus on:

- That God calls us to love others; ways in which we can participate in God's call for us to love others.
- Considering ways in which to incorporate prayer into daily life

In our R.E topic 'Prophecy and Promise' we will:

- Show understanding of how and why the Magnificat prayer forms radical expectations of the Messiah.
- Describe and explain the belief that Mary became the 'Mother of God'.
- Contrast Luke 1:26-56 it with Matthew's account
- Show understanding of the Christian belief that Mary is the fulfilment of the Old Testament promises
- Show understanding of the life of individual women today who are responding to God's call in their life, making relevant links to Mary's 'yes' to God

In our Mathematics learning the class will be:

- Multiplying and dividing whole numbers by 10, 100 and 1000.
- Multiplying numbers up to 4 digits by a one or two digit number using a formal written method, including long multiplication for 2 digit numbers.
- Dividing numbers up to 4 digits by a one digit number using the formal written method of short division and interpret remainders appropriately for the context.
- Identifying multiples and factors, including finding all factor pairs of a number, and common factors of two numbers.
- Recognising and using square numbers and cube numbers and the notation for squared (2) and cubed (3).
- Completing, reading and interpreting information in tables including timetables.

In History and Geography we will be learning about:

- The Wars of the Roses and the Battle of Bosworth.
- The Tudor monarchs.
- Key events that occurred during the Tudor era.
- Tudor medicine.
- Crime and punishment.
- Tudor entertainment.
- Everyday life for rich and poor Tudors.

In our Art and Design lessons, we will be:

- Developing our sketching skills to create a Tudor style portrait.
- Use a range of joining techniques to construct a sturdy Tudor style building.
