In Literacy we will be:

- Reading a selection of books about London
- Continuing to learn the initial sounds, Phase 2, Phase 3, Phase 4 and 5.
- Continuously developing our cursive handwriting.
- Reading poems about London
- Designing posters for a Tea party
- Listen and discuss a wide range of poems and recite some from the heart
- Writing a recount of a special school journey into London
- Recap on writing full sentences with correct use of basic punctuation.

In Science we will be learning about Plants looking at:

- Identify and name a variety of common wild and garden plants, including deciduous and evergreen trees
- identify and describe the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants, including trees

In our R.E topic 'To the End of the Earth' we will be looking and learning about:

- Easter
- Jesus rose from the dead
- Jesus appears to the Disciples
- Jesus eats with the Disciples
- Jesus and Thomas
- Jesus return to Heaven

In Computing we will be:

- Using ipads Reading Eggs
- Use technology purposefully to create, organise, store, manipulate and retrieve digital content.
- Exploring the keyboard
- Adding and removing text on a a computer
- Exploring the toolbar and identifying that the look of a text can be changed on a computer
- To say that tools I have used to change the text
- Compare typing on a computer to writing on paper

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In our Art and Design, we will be:

- Use drawing, painting and to develop and share ideas, experiences and imagination
- Learn about the work of a range of artists, craft makers and designers, describing the differences and similarities between different practises and disciplines, making links to their own work
- Drawing and painting London landmarks

In P.E we will be learning about: Exploring Movement Concepts.

- Developing jumping for height and distance.
- To move in time to rhythm.
- Developing catching a ball from various positions.

In our Mathematics learning the class will be looking at:

- Count in 2s, 5s and 10s
- Understand how to make equal groups and arrays
- Recognising halves and quarters of shapes and numbers
- Describing turn and directions
- Counting to 100 and backwards
- Ordering numbers and comparing numbers to 100 <>
- Recognising coins
- To be able to tell time to the hour, half past

In Geography we will be learning about:

- Name, locate and identify characteristics of the four countries and capital cities of the UK and its surrounding seas.
- Use simple compass directions (North, South, East and West) and locational and directional language (e.g. near and far; left and right), to describe the location of features and routes on a map.
- Use basic geographical vocabulary to refer to key human features, including: city, town, village, factory

In History we will be learning about:

- Events beyond living memory that are significant nationally or globally
- The lives of significant individuals in the past
- Significant historical events, people and places in their own locality (The Great Fire of London)
- Changes within living memory
